Our initiatives include

- Building teacher capability:
 - in the teaching of reading
 - to identify, plan and teach the literacy and numeracy demands of the curriculum
- Enhancing inclusive focused intervention for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the NAPLAN minimum standard for reading and Level of Achievement for English, Maths and Science
- Developing a responsive strategy to support student attendance at school
